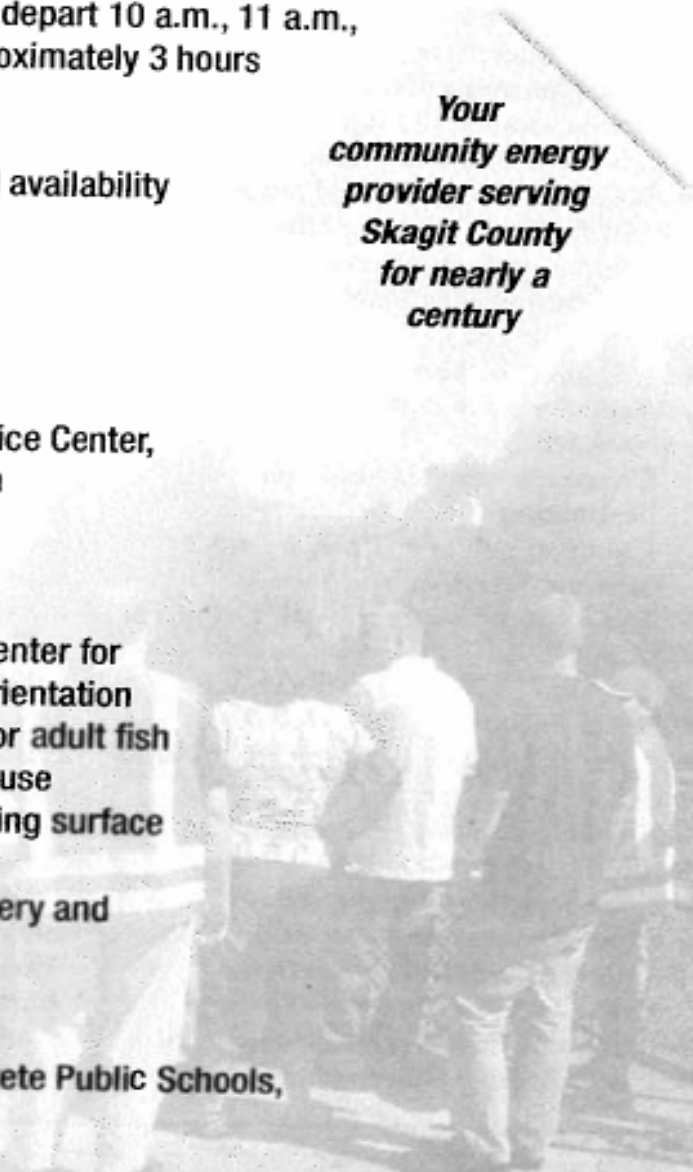
Tour stops include:

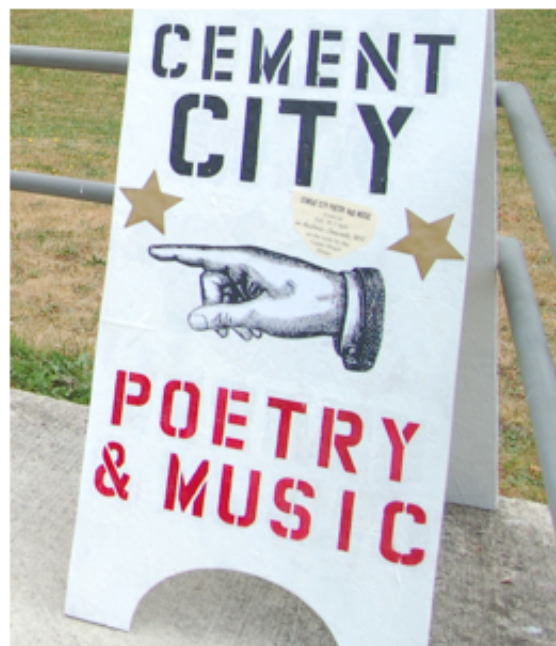
